Dear Friend:

What a Satanic mess we've lived through in 2020! The president was impeached! The coronavirus struck! Wildfires destroyed many of our forests! People followed Communists and went wild, burning our cities! I myself could no longer stand up to preach! "Some (departed) from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron" (I Timothy 4:1, 2)! Even the Pope endorsed same-sex unions! It seemed like the whole world was ready to explode; Jesus said,

"And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring; Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken. And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh" (Luke 21:25-28).

March 1 was our last Sunday in the old building on Hope Street. For the rest of the year (2020) we met in two houses, due to the coronavirus. Each week I record a lesson on video, which is played in the two houses. After the teaching video we have dinner.

My 79th birthday fell on Easter Sunday, April 12. We also celebrated Mrs. Hymers' birthday on April 16. I can say, "Many daughters have done virtuously, but thou excellest them all" (Proverbs 31:29).

On September 27 the church celebrated our 38th wedding anniversary. For the past year I have suffered from lower bowel disease, which made it impossible for me to stand up and preach. It was the intense radiation for cancer that destroyed a nerve that brought on this disease, which is like Crohn's Disease.

Yet, in the same year, God has blessed our work! We added three more languages of verse-by-verse Bible studies and sermons on our website at www.sermonsfortheworld.com. We added Khongso Chin, a local language of Myanmar (Burma) as our 43rd language. We also added Malayalam, another language of India, as our 44th language. And then we added Sinhala, the language of Sri Lanka, as our 45th language.

I receive wonderful emails each week from preachers all over the world telling us how much those lessons and sermons have helped them.

On July 7 escrow opened on our old building on Hope Street, thanks largely to the work our son Robert did.

On October 13 the whole church celebrated the life of Eugene Grace at his service held at Riverside National Cemetery. Dr. Cagan had led Mr. Grace to trust Jesus a couple of hours before he passed away at the age of 91. Mr. Grace was the stepfather of Tom Xia, a fine young member of our church. A couple of weeks later, Dr. Cagan presented the good news of the Gospel to Mr. Grace's wife, Sophie, and she now has eternal life. She will hopefully be the first person we baptize in our new location in San Gabriel. Mrs. Hymers drove me to Riverside to attend Mr. Grace's funeral service. Then she drove me to Oxnard, where we spent a couple of days resting near the beach.

On November 22 (Sunday) we will have a Thanksgiving banquet scheduled at Dr. Cagan's house in Alhambra.

I am still working, writing lessons and sermons, and helping Dr. Cagan. In a few weeks, I will enter the 81st year of my life. I could not continue working if it were not for my precious wife, Ileana – and for Jesus from whom I receive strength to carry on.

"I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me" (Philippians 4:13).

This is the promise of Jesus! I will close this letter by quoting the testimony of my partner, Dr. Christopher L. Cagan:

Years ago I had no peace. I was living for myself. I didn't think about God or what would happen when I died. I was trusting myself. I was running and hiding from God. I got A's in college and made a lot of money, but I was lonely and unhappy.

Then I met some Christians who were nice to me. I began to go to church. But I still wanted to live my own way. One night I went to a meeting at school. A young man told me the best news I'd ever heard – that God loved me and wanted to give me eternal life. He told me how to receive that life. That night I trusted Jesus. He forgave my sins and gave me eternal life.

Now I have peace. Now I have eternal life. Jesus healed me inside. He gave me hope and happiness. I'm not lonely any more. I know if I died tonight, I would go to be with God in Heaven, because Jesus has given me eternal life!

I am so glad to be working for Jesus! I could not do that without His power and grace, and without Dr. Cagan, Ileana, and our son John Wesley, who will be studying phlebotomy and related subjects at college next spring.
